ANNUAL PRODUCTION LIMIT ORDER

Alcoholic Beverage Code Sections 12.052(f) and 62.122(f) require the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission (Commission) to annually adjust the production limit prescribed by Subsection (c)(2) of those sections in an amount that is equal to the percentage of the state's population growth for the previous year, as determined by the State Demographer.

According to the State Demographer, the population of the State of Texas grew by 1.28 percent from January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019.


The annual production limit prescribed by Order of the Commission dated January 22, 2019, was 177,275 barrels. Applying the 1.28 percent 2019 population growth figure to the 177,275-barrel production limit set forth in the 2019 Commission Order equals 2,269 barrels.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT THE ANNUAL PRODUCTION LIMIT FOR 2020 UNDER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CODE SECTIONS 12.052(c)(2) AND 62.122(c)(2) IS 179,544 BARRELS.
